READ

Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise! Give thanks to him; bless his name! Psalm 100:4

Romans 1:21: 1 Thess 5:16-18; Heb 12:11

REFLECT

Paul, the author of the book of Romans, contrasts the **priority** of honouring God and giving thanks to him with what happens when we don't.

Qu: Why do you think that when we cease to give thanks our minds become futile in their thinking?

Qu: Similarly, why do you think that our hearts become darkened?

There is a **<u>problem</u>** with thanksgiving – life is not always easy and therefore it's sometimes really hard to be thankful.

Three things we can be thankful for in hard times

- For spiritual self-awareness. Acknowledging our feelings allows us to lament.
- For the opportunity to expose our personal fault lines and idols.
- 3) That we grow more in times of pressure that we do in times of ease.
