INTRO

READ

Acts 11:19-26

Antioch was the 3rd largest city in the ancient Roman world with a population of 500,000. It was a wealthy city and ethnically diverse. Its population included Greek, Roman, Jewish, Arabic, Persians and more.

Key Verse:

So Barnabas went to Tarsus to look for Saul, ²⁶ and when he had found him, he brought him to Antioch, v25-26a

What happened through Paul in the Antioch church was nothing short of spectacular. Paul was the right person, in the right place, with the right purpose. That one divine placement changed the face of the church and eventually the world as Antioch became the most powerful missional church of the era.

Qu: What does being sent into the world look like for you individually and for us as a church?
