### REFLECT

The struggle between private and public faith can create a tension that we all experience. Joseph was a secret disciple because he feared the opinions of his contemporaries, which could lead to the loss of his position and status.

### **The Cross Confronts and Reveals**

Jesus' death on the cross triggered Joseph's decision to step out, risking all by asking Pilate for Jesus' body to offer him an honourable burial.

# Costly vs. Cheap Grace

"Cheap grace is the grace we bestow on ourselves... grace without discipleship, grace without the cross, grace without Jesus Christ.... Costly grace is the gospel which must be sought again and again.... Such grace is costly because it calls us to follow, and it is grace because it calls us to follow Jesus Christ. It is costly because it costs a man his life, and it is grace because it gives a man the only true life. It is costly because it condemns sin, and grace

because it justifies the sinner. Above all, it is costly because it cost God the life of his Son, and what has cost God much cannot be cheap for us." — Dietrich Bonhoeffer
