

**INTRO**

- When you hear the word 'faith,' what comes to mind?

**READ**

Hebrews 11

Key Scripture:

*"Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen." 11:1*

**REFLECT & RESPOND**

Faith is not an emotion we work up in ourselves. It rests on two solid foundations: **God's Word** and **God's Character**. Hebrews 11, often known as the "Hall of Faith," reminds us:

1. God is pleased with those who seek Him sincerely
2. God approves of those who follow Him, no matter what the circumstances
3. God always has something better ahead

**1. Seeking God Sincerely**

We're to seek God sincerely, earnestly, and diligently.

*Q: What's the difference between these three approaches? Which one do you find most challenging?*

**2. Follow God Through Difficult Times**

Hebrews 11 recounts the heroes of the faith, some of whom saw miracles and others who suffered greatly.

*Q: Why do you think God includes both types of stories in the "Hall of Faith"?*

*Q: Is there an area where you've been tempted to give up because you haven't seen the breakthrough you're praying for? How does Heb 11 speak to your situation?*

**3. Trusting God's Better Plan**

One example is Abraham, who tells us he left his comfortable home to live in tents because he was "looking forward to the city that has foundations, whose designer and builder is God."

*Q: What might God be asking you to leave behind or step away from to pursue His better plan?*

**Personal Application:**

- Am I seeking God sincerely, earnestly, and diligently?
- Do I complain when things don't go the way I want them to go and then give up?
- Am I trusting that God is working on something better up ahead?

*"We are not of those who shrink back and are destroyed, but of those who have faith and preserve their souls." - Hebrews 10:39*

Remember: Faith acts on solid facts—God's Word and God's Character. No matter what you're facing, God has something better ahead for you.

**PRAY**

- Pray for these three areas:
  - For those who want to seek God more sincerely: Pray for grace, discipline, and hunger for God's presence.
  - For those facing difficult circumstances: Pray for perseverance, hope, and freedom from complaining spirits.
  - For those needing to trust God's better plan: Pray for renewed faith and confidence in God's character and promises.
